

UNDERSCORING THE NEED FOR SWIM EDUCATION

Our work at Step Into Swim is truly lifesaving. Learning to swim from a qualified instructor reduces the risk of drowning by 88% among children ages 1 to 4, which is why we are committed to reaching as many children as possible through our program.

Step Into Swim and PHTA partnered with The Harris Poll to conduct a consumer survey* to better understand parents' perspectives on water safety and to inform our advocacy for swim education. The results show parents are concerned about their children's swimming abilities and further underscore the importance of swimming lessons for all children. Key survey findings show that among parents who have a child ages 14 or under:



83% of parents are confident in their child's ability to be safe in the water



65% say they are concerned about their child drowning in a pool



81% of parents say they and their family have access to a pool, most commonly a community or public swimming pool (33%)



Only 54% plan to enroll their child in formal swimming lessons this year (2022)



Less than half of parents (48%) are confident in their own swimming abilities, only 33% have had formal swimming lessons, and just one quarter (25%) are CPR certified

*This survey was conducted online within the United States by The Harris Poll on behalf of PHTA from March 31-April 4, 2022 among 606 U.S. adults ages 18 and older who are parents of kids 14 and under. The sampling precision of Harris online polls is measured by using a Bayesian credible interval. For this study, the sample data is accurate to within +2.8 percentage points using a 95% confidence level.

EMPOWERING THE NEXT **GENERATION OF SWIMMERS**





Step Into Swim is PHTA's philanthropic endeavor to make a difference in swimming communities nationwide, which means all our members have an opportunity to play an active role in getting new swimmers comfortable in the water.

The average cost of a swim lesson varies depending on the geographic location and type of instruction. Considering the cost of lessons and understanding the need for proper swim education to prevent drowning, it is our goal to raise \$750,000 a year. This will allow us to provide free swimming lessons through grants and partnerships with swim schools across the country and create educational programming.

Step Into Swim can help millions of parents and swimmers build confidence in the water and understand the fundamentals of water safety, thereby reducing the number of drowning deaths reported in the U.S. But we can't do this alone. We need you and your support.

SHOW YOUR SUPPORT

At Step Into Swim we know that drowning affects people of all social and economic backgrounds, and it is our mission to create more swimmers regardless of income or cultural standing. Each year, PHTA accepts applications from new and/or recurring organizations and a selection committee appropriately grants funds. 100% of donations go directly to Step Into Swim initiatives and learn-to-swim programming. On average, it costs Step Into Swim \$50* per child to provide swimming lessons. Your donation directly contributes to ensuring children get the education they need to thrive in and around the water.

Tiered Donor Levels:

- Friend Level: \$1-\$999 (up to 19 children)
- Bronze Level: \$1,000-\$4,999 (20-99 children)
- **Silver Level:** \$5,000-\$19,999 (100-399 children)
- Gold Level: \$20,000-\$49,999 (400-999 children)
- Platinum Level: \$50,000-\$99,999 (1,000-1,999 children)
- Diamond Level: \$100,000+ (2,000+ children)
